

**UPDATE TO 2018 MORTON COUNTY PROJECT SUMMARY:** Two areas within the project site, each encompassing about one acre, were set aside for tree plantings. Over 730 trees were planted in 11 rows in the north area and 14 rows in the south area as shown below. Some of the species planted included Rocky Mountain Juniper, Black Hills Spruce, Hackberry, Scotch Pine, American Plum, Buffaloberry, Nannyberry Viburnum, Skunkbush Sumac and Crabapple. Fencing was installed to protect the young trees. The work was performed by the Morton County Soil Conservation District in June, 2019.
