NOTICE OF ORDER INTERIM SUSPENSION OF ATTORNEY

Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of the State of North Dakota, Petitioner  
v.  
James G. Wolff, Respondent  
No. 20100150  
Disciplinary Counsel filed an Application for Order of Interim Suspension of James G. Wolff on May 20, 2010, under N.D.R. Lawyer Disciplinary Conduct. The Application stated that Wolff had been convicted of a Class C Felony, Issuing Check or Draft Without Sufficient Funds or Credit. Under the rule, any felony is considered a serious crime, and upon satisfactory evidence demonstrating that a lawyer has been convicted of a serious crime, the Court shall enter an order immediately suspending the lawyer pending final disposition of a disciplinary proceeding predicated on the conviction. On June 24, 2009, Wolff had previously been suspended based on other criminal charges. Disciplinary Board v. Wolff, 2009 ND 111, 767 N.W.2d 170. The Supreme Court adopted Disciplinary Counsel's recommendation, and continued the suspension of James G. Wolff until further order of the Court, pending final disposition of the disciplinary proceedings predicated upon the criminal complaints filed.
