# 2010 Cost Share Program Individuals

The Benson County Weed Board will cost share for the purchase of chemicals for the use of spraying leafy spurge in Benson County. Certain policies and procedures must be followed to receive the 80 percent cost share.

1. Chemical can be purchased from area dealers in Benson County, Devils Lake and Rugby, North Dakota.
  2. The landowner or renter may purchase chemical from the dealer of his choice after Thursday, May 10, 2010. The landowner/renter must have a restricted chemical use certification to pick up Tordon chemical.
  3. The landowner/renter must submit an FSA map, with the area to be sprayed marked on the map, the estimated acres to be sprayed, along with a copy of the receipt for chemical purchased. The weed to be sprayed, along with the approximate acres, is also to be on the map. The dealer WILL NOT distribute chemical for the Benson County Cost Share Program without an FSA map. Receipts and maps can be mailed to: Benson County Weed Board, PO Box 38, Minnewaukan, ND 58351.
  4. The cost share program will be run until June 26, 2010, or until Weed Board funds are exhausted, whichever comes first.
  5. The Benson County Weed Board will cost share 80 percent on a maximum of \$600.00 per landowner or renter.
  6. A two-party check will be issued to the landowner and dealer upon receipt of map and chemical receipt. The landowner should endorse and return check to dealer as soon as possible.
- The Benson County Weed Board is obligated to spot check areas that are marked on the maps. If any chemical purchased on the cost share program in Benson County is used outside the county, or sold, the individual(s) involved will be prosecuted.
- The law states that as a landowner it is your responsibility to control noxious weeds on your land. The following is a list of noxious weeds in Benson County: Absinth Wormwood, Canada Thistle, Field Bindweed, Leafy Spurge, Musk Thistle, Russian Knapweed, Spotted Knapweed, Diffuse Knapweed, Purple Loose strife and Yellow Star Thistle. Two new species have been added to the noxious weed list and they are salt cedar and Dalmation toadflax.
