PSC to Hold Informal Hearing Today to Discuss Recent Xcel Power Outages in Fargo

BISMARCK, ND – The North Dakota Public Service Commission (PSC) will hold an informal hearing this afternoon, May 18, at 1:30 p.m. to discuss the recent Xcel Energy power outages in the Fargo area. During the hearing, the Commissioners will hear from Xcel representatives in more detail about the causes of the outages and identify a course of action for improving reliability.
